### RAINHAM ANTI-IDLING PROJECT WORKSHOP

It was excellent to attend two very productive workshops for the vehicle anti-idling project. The project is a partnership between Medway Council and the University of Kent with funding awarded by DEFRA to help improve the air quality along the A2 (High Street) corridor. Through the excellent efforts of local resident and clean air campaigner, Alan Stockley, workshops to design effective signage were facilitated by Alan at The Howard School (with students from Rainham Mark and Rainham School for Girls also attending), and for adults at St Margaret's Church with the support of the church and the Eco Hub.

## SPLASHES - THE WORK BEGINS

We are pleased to share with you that work is now underway on the construction of the new Splashes Leisure Centre, opening for summer next year.

It's great to see things moving along rapidly and we look forward to seeing the structure rising out of the ground soon. Whilst swimming pools are being closed up and down the country, your local Conservative Councillors and Conservative Council will

deliver a new state of the art leisure centre for Rainham and Medway which will include:

- a leisure pool with a flume, wave ball and kids beach,
- a four-lane 25 metre pool,
- a fitness gym and multi-purpose fitness studio,
- a cafeteria with viewing area.

## GP SERVICES AT RAINHAM HEALTHY LIVING CENTRE

Your team of Conservative Councillors in Rainham have continued to fight to ensure access to local GP surgeries in Rainham. They challenged the local NHS on the Green Suite consolidating at Woodlands Road in 2018, submitted a petition in 2021 following the Blue Suite doing the same with Long Catlis Road, and Cllr Martin Potter recently held the NHS to account with regards to our further concerns about the Yellow Suite operating a hub model under Maritime Health. It's good news that the new Kent and Medway Medical School will support GP recruitment, but Kwashie, George and Wayne will continue to battle for local and timely access to services and they want to see this purpose built health facility in the centre of Rainham fully utilised for health services.
